Healthy Adults Need to Be Vigilant!

Workshop provided by PACE

PACE has been part of the Northwest Region of Alberta providing crisis intervention, counseling, & professional awareness training on sexual abuse and trauma for 32 years.

In 2011 PACE provided therapy to 397 individuals; provided family support and youth work to 237 children and 193 parents; coordinated crisis intervention and critical response services to 652 individuals following traumatic events; and provided training to 2831 students and community caregivers.

This workshop will help parents and guardians understand:

- 1) The magnitude of child sexual abuse, the impact on the child, family, and community.
- 2) Offender realities: an offender's ability to manipulate and hide behavior.
- 3) The need for healthy adults to be vigilant and protect children from child sexual abuse.
- 4) How to foster an open, non-judgmental environment to talk with children to lessen risk and trauma.
- 5) How to support and access resources for a child or individual who has been sexually abused.
